Our History

TASC started as the brainchild of Dr. Andrew Smyth. His mother who had breast and, eventually, liver cancer brought people together with her gourmet food. Dr. Smyth wanted to bring people together in his own special way; with sports. He wanted to make it fun and allow others to benefit from it. It was originally called the "The Betty Smyth Softball Classic," and was run from 1991-1993. In 1996, it was recreated as "Take a Swing at Cancer '96" and has since been an annual event. The charity initially ran under the American Cancer Society, but broke away and formed its own organization in 1998. The golf tournament was added in 1999 and has been an annual event ever since. The organization has had a number of other leaders that have shaped us and continued our growth. Since 2000, an estimated \$150,000 has been distributed to our beneficiaries. Our organization is striving to help a larger number of families by raising funds through the addition of sponsorships, pledge-a-thon teams, and new volunteers.

2006 Softball Tournament

The coed event is a fun softball tournament. There is a maximum of 15 member per team, and each team must field a minimum of 2 women and 2 men (children under 12 may be substituted). Teams may register for Saturday, Sunday or both. Each day is a separate tournament that starts with round robin format (min. 3 games) with teams advancing to single elimination playoffs in the afternoon. Teams typically play 2 games in morning and 1 in the afternoon. Games are ASA slow pitch and last approximately one hour. Batters start with a 2 and 2 count.

Other activities during the event include:

- Throwing Accuracy Contest
- Prizes and Silent Auction
